Be aware that Cassis is very popular with tourists from June onwards, so please **book your accommodation** as early as possible

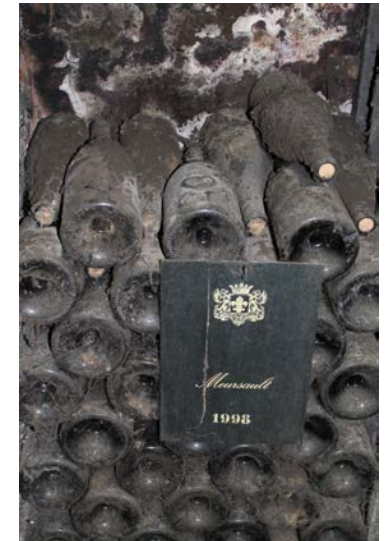

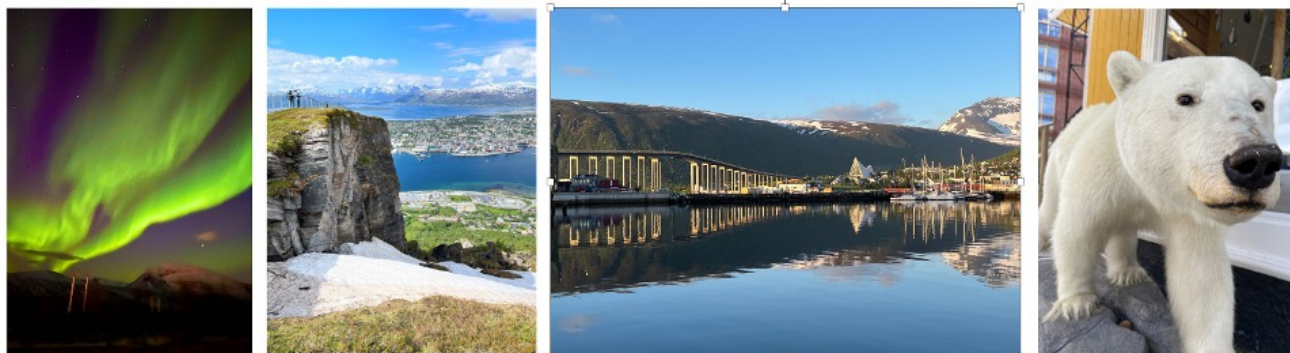

We welcome short communications, full papers, and review articles. The deadline for the receipt of manuscripts is **September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023** (no further extension), but early submissions would be much appreciated. Publication is provisionally scheduled for fall time.
